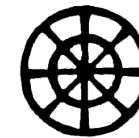
New Creation Teaching Ministry

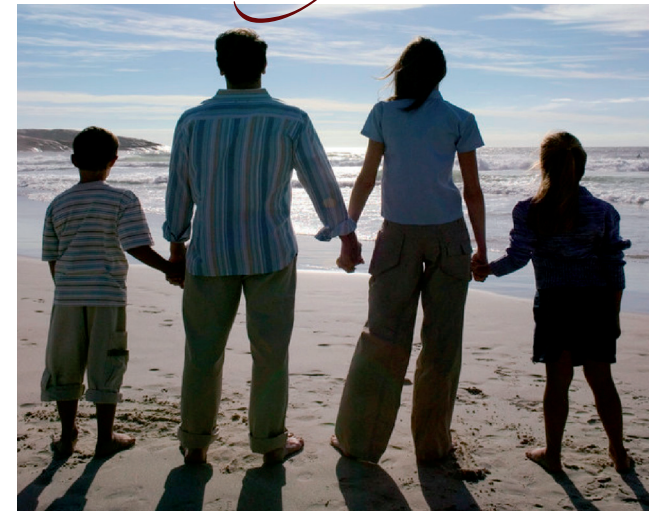

PEOPLE of THE KINGDOM

In the midst of the kingdoms of this world, and our little or big efforts at kingdom-building, there is a people who belong to another Kingdom that is not of this world.
